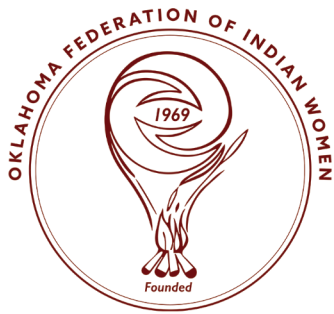

Annual Events

Oklahoma Federation of Indian Women's Annual Events

Miss & Jr Miss Indian Oklahoma Pageant: \$10,000 - \$12,000

The Miss & Junior Miss Indian Oklahoma Pageant attracts a wide variety of people, including American Indian educators, tribal administrators, tribal leaders, organizations and friends/families of all the Miss and Junior Miss Indian Oklahoma candidates and reigning/former titleholders.



The titles of Miss Indian Oklahoma and Junior Miss Indian Oklahoma are owned by the Oklahoma Federation of Indian Women. Titleholders serve as goodwill ambassadors that represent the Oklahoma Federation of Indian Women, all Oklahoma tribes and the state of Oklahoma. The first Miss Indian Oklahoma was crowned in 1973, and the first Jr. Miss Indian Oklahoma was crowned ten years later in 1983.

Each year, Miss Indian Oklahoma and Junior Miss Indian Oklahoma are selected by acquiring points in a variety of categories and must possess cultural knowledge of their tribe they will be representing on stage. Each candidate is required to compete in the areas of: written essay, judges interview, introductions & tribal greeting, traditional talent or presentation, platform presentation, and impromptu question.

When possible, and with sponsorship, the Oklahoma Federation of Indian Women will provide the titleholders a scholarship at the completion of their reign. Funding for the pageant is sought to help with event venue costs including any venue rental fees, technology, sound and stage equipment; candidate and titleholder awards, banners, shawls; and the scholarship fund.



With sponsorship, we are able to host this event free and open to the public to broaden our audience and give positive exposure for our amazing candidates.

This year, the Miss & Junior Miss Indian Oklahoma Pageant will be on Saturday, November 8, 2025 at River Spirit Casino & Resort in Tulsa.



Statewide Awards & Honor Banquet: \$2,000 - \$3,000



The Statewide Awards and Honor Banquet is a special by invitation only annual event hosted by the OFIW to acknowledge the Statewide Award winners and honor the outgoing Miss & Jr. Miss Indian Oklahoma. OFIW honors nine individuals every year who are nominated for an OFIW Statewide Award. OFIW Statewide awards include: Nancy Tsoodle Student Achievement Award, Boyce Timmons Student Achievement Award, Alice Timmons Founders Award, Georgeann Robinson Humanitarian Award, Mary Townsend Crow Service Award, Helen Chupco Leadership Award, Angela Kihega Outstanding

OFIW Member, American Indian Mother of the Year and American Indian Woman of the Year. OFIW is committed to this event in order to celebrate and recognize the accomplishments of our American Indian women, leaders and students inside and outside our organization.

Funding for the Statewide Awards & Honor Banquet includes event venue costs, dinner provided to all attendees, awards, shawls for the American Indian Woman of the Year and American Indian Mother of the Year, and entertainment.

Miss & Junior Miss Indian Oklahoma Honor Powwow: \$2,500 - \$5,000

The Miss & Jr. Miss Indian Oklahoma Honor Powwow is a cultural event that is free, family oriented, and open to the public. The powwow honors the outgoing titleholders: Miss Indian Oklahoma and Junior Miss Indian Oklahoma. The Oklahoma Federation of Indian Women takes pride and works together to host this event. The goal of the Miss & Jr. Miss Indian Oklahoma Honor Powwow is to promote & celebrate our Indian Women and our American Indian culture through dancing, singing, and supporting arts & crafts. Our honor dance can be a full day powwow that includes gourd dancing, dinner, contests, and inter-tribal dancing, or a half-day powwow. Funding for the Miss & Junior Miss Indian Oklahoma Honor Powwow includes event venue costs, head staff honorariums, contest prizes, and miscellaneous supplies.
